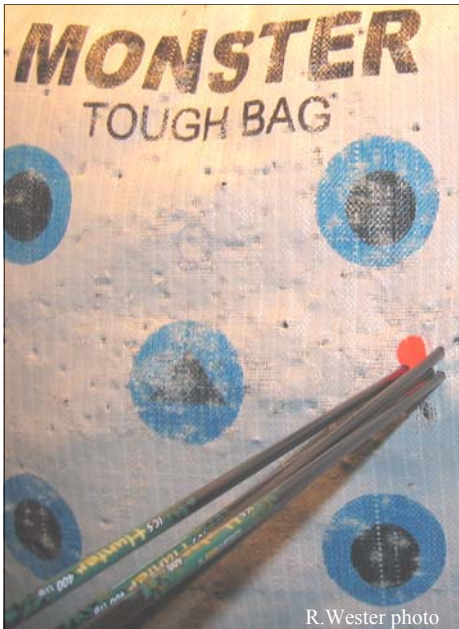

Firearm Safety Class February 23rd & 24th

2006 Light Rifle Championship Bruce Hastings wins by Slim 2x Margin

The Light Rifle Championship was held at the clubhouse on January 14th. After 60 shots Jim Maxant and Bruce Hastings had fired identical scores of 572. The winner was determined by counting center tens known as X's. The final score was Bruce Hastings 572 - 20x, Jim Maxant 572 - 18x. The event included three positions. In the prone position Doug Flavin shooting a vintage Remington 513 equipped with Redfield iron sights fired a perfect 200 score. Doug was the only iron sight shooter. Bruce Hastings fired a modified Ruger 10/22. Modifications to Bruce's rifle included a Custom Power trigger group, Whistle Pig barrel, Fajan thumbhole stock, and a Tasco 3 x 9 x 60mm scope.
