Bruce Hastings Repeats as 2005 Club 10m Air Pistol Champ

Bruce Hastings success in the Target Pistol event carried over to the 10m Air Pistol Championship Match. The required skill set for the two events is quite similar. The trick is to hold a steady sight picture while squeezing off the shot. Bruce fired the top score to repeat as Club Champion again this year. Bruce used a Russian made Baikal .177 single pump match grade air pistol to take the title. The other shooters used Daisy 747 single pump match grade air pistols.

Doug Flavin takes 2005 Practical Pistol Championship

Doug Flavin took 1st place in this years Practical Pistol Championship event. Speed was the difference. Doug did not lose any points to overtime shots while the other competitors did. This year the Crawford Barricade format was used with 10 point penalties assessed for shots after the allowed time. Shooters fired six shots with the strong hand from the right side of the barricade in 8 seconds. Then after reloading six shots from the left side of the barricade, again with the strong hand. This was done at 10, and 15 yards on the NRA Action Pistol D-1 target. Then from 25 and 35 feet using the reduced size D-2 target. On paper this course of fire looked easy. But the time limits were deceptive. Doug Flavin was the only shooter that did not receive at least one ten point penalty.
