2nd Quarter Points per Second Match For Centerfire Pistol June 26th

The second quarter points per second centerfire pistol and revolver match was held on Tuesday evening June 26, 2007. Jim Maxant and Doug Flavin advanced to the final round where Jim fired 5.647 points per second to win the event. Doug's second place finish with a score of 4.462 pps. Was due in part to a jam on the second string of six shots. This is high speed, short distance competition. Speed reloading is required so shooters need extra magazines, or speed loaders. Points scored are divided by elapsed time to arrive at a points per second score. There was one non-dominant hand target. The 3rd Quarter PPS match will be held in September.
