- Methods:** No restrictions. All lawful fishing methods are allowed.
- Categories:** Trout/Salmon, Largemouth Bass, Smallmouth Bass, Striped Bass, and Bluefish.
- To Enter:** Take a picture of your catch. Send the picture in to rfgirvin@yahoo.com or bring it to the club house. Provide the following information:
Fisherman's name, Species, Length, Date of Catch, Location (general) of Catch, Method used. All entries must be received no later than Wednesday January 4, 2012.
- Awards:** Biggest fish in each category - fisherman's name engraved on the perpetual Big Fish Tournament Trophy on display in the clubhouse trophy case. Gold, Silver, and Bronze fish pins awarded to 1st, 2nd, and 3rd place winners in each category.
