Over the next few months, GOAL will begin to schedule shooting events in several different disciplines. These matches will be annually to decide who will be the GOAL Cup Challenge Series Champion in as many different disciplines as we can schedule. The concept for this new program was derived from GOAL Board Member Don Kusser's annual Black Powder GOAL cup shoot. Don has held this team shoot at the Braintree Rifle and Pistol Club for the past several years. GOAL recently decided to expand on Don's original idea to include as many competitions as we can schedule. We are proud to announce that The North Leominster Rod & Gun Club has generously offered to host our first GOAL Cup Challenge Series event. This event will take place on Saturday, June 16, 2007 and will be the Trap Shooters GOAL Cup Challenge. The shoot will be combined with a pig roast and an auction to benefit the GOAL Heritage Program. Practical Pistol Points Per Second Match Scheduled for March 15th

Rules:	Current N.R.A. Action Pistol Shooting Rules will apply.
Competition open to:	Members of the Holliston Sportsmen's Association.
Registration Fee:	None - Competitors will receive a copy of the official match bulletin.
Entry Fee:	\$10
Entries Close:	7:15PM March 15, 2007
Post Entries:	Post entries – Does not apply
Entry Limit:	Space will be allocated to the first 10 paid entrants.
Firing Starts:	First relay 7:30PM.
Classification of Competitors:	All Classifications will be combined for award purposes.
Awards:	Winner of the Final round will receive 50% of the entry fees collected. Runner-up will receive 25% of the entry fees collected.

MATCH SCHEDULE AND CONDITIONS:

Qualification Round (all shooters participate)

36 shots total – Targets: B-24 at 5 yards, 7 yards, 10 yards.

Match 1 – At five yards: Using the dominant hand supported by non-dominant hand, starting from the ready position. At the starting signal shooters fire six shots, reload, and fire six more shots.

Match 2 – At seven yards: Using the non-dominant hand supported by the dominant hand starting from the ready position. At the starting signal shooters fire six shots, reload, and fire six more shots.

Match 3 – At ten yards: Using the dominant hand supported by non-dominant hand, starting from the ready position. At the starting signal shooters fire six shots, reload, and fire six more shots.

Semi-final Round - top four combined pps scores from the qualifying round participate as follows: Number 1 vs. Number 4, Number 2 vs. Number 3.

12 shots total – Target B-24 at ten yards.

Match 4 - At Ten yards: Using the dominant hand supported by non-dominant hand, starting from the ready position. At the starting signal shooters fire six shots, reload, and fire six more shots.

Final Round – winners of the semi-final round matches participate.

12 shots total – Target B-24 at ten yards.

Match 5 - At Ten yards: Using the dominant hand supported by non-dominant hand, starting from the ready position. At the starting signal shooters fire six shots, reload, and fire six more shots.

Firearms: Open Firearm (rule 3.1) – any pistol, or revolver in serviceable and safe condition.

Ammunition: The lower limit of caliber shall be 9mm.
