Target Pistol Club Championship November 9th

The Annual Club Championship for Target Pistol will be held on the indoor range on Tuesday November 9th. The first relay shoots at 7:00PM. The course of fire will be a Standard 900 match, 30 shots slow fire, 30 shots timed fire, and 30 shots rapid fire. Any pistol, and any sight (except those that project a laser beam onto the target) is allowed. This match is also one of the six ARBS events. There are no entry fees for the championship events.
