- 30 Shots slow fire, B-2 target;
- 30 Shots timed fire, B-3 target;
- 30 Shots rapid fire, B-3 target;

High aggregate score wins the club championship for 2006.

**2006 Action Pistol Championship
November 19th**

The 2006 Action pistol championship will be held on Sunday November 19th. The first relay starts at 1:00PM. The event will be a Crawford Barricade match. Minimum caliber is 9mm. All dominate hand shooting from left and right sides of the barricade. Forty-eight shots total. Targets will be the D-1 and D-2 action pistol targets. Distances will be 10 yards, 15 yards, and simulated 25 and 35 yards using the D-2 target.
