Junior Rifle Club got underway in October. Ten young markspersons have signed up, six returns from last year, and four new shooters. This is a full roster. Additional applicants will be put on a waiting list (room will be available to H.S.A. members kids). The JRC meets every Monday evening at the clubhouse from 7:00 to 9:00PM. The shooters participate in NRA qualification shooting, earning awards for their shooting. Several shooters have already completed their pro-marksman, and marksman qualification ratings in October. The Juniors also participate in inter club league shoots with juniors from the Harvard Sportsmen's Association, and the Southborough Rod and Gun Club. These matches provide some real excitement for the youngsters, and a great introduction to three position smallbore rifle competition. In November we have Harvard away on the 16th, and Southborough at home on the 26th. After more than thirty years of service we have finally retired out government surplus Remington MatchMaster 513T rifles. The kids are enjoying new RAAC CM2 Cadet rifles, and the two brand new Anschutz 1903 Junior rifles purchased with the grant money from the NRA Foundation.
