All Round Best Shooter (ARBS) 2005 Gets Underway this Month

Each year the H.S.A. holds a series of six shooting events. The six events are the club championship events. These are listed in the schedule to the right. The All Round Best Shooter title is determined by combining the score (converted to a percentage of possible score) from at least four of the championship events. If a member competes in five or six events then the highest four scores are used to calculate their ARBS score. The winners of the various events are recognized at the annual meeting in February, and their names are engraved on the championship trophies that are displayed in the clubhouse trophy case. Two events are scheduled for October. The Club Trap Shooting Championship will be held on Sunday October 16. This is followed by the Archery Championship match on Sunday October 30. These events provide a good opportunity to enjoy a little friendly competition. Give it a shot!
