William Spencer Liscombe, 79, died on Wednesday August 6, 2003, at the home of his son Ted Liscombe. He was the husband of Violet (Greenwood) Liscombe, who died in 1977, and Barbara (Simone) Doyle Liscombe, who died in 1997. An avid sportsmen, he enjoyed all phases of hunting, and fishing. Bill served as president of the H.S.A. for several terms beginning in the early 1960's. He was the Chief Junior Rifle Club Instructor for many years. Bill was active in the construction of the trout pond. He served the Association in many capacities as Chairman of various committees. In addition to his club activities Bill also served on the Holliston Conservation Commission. Bill remained active in the club until moving to Florida in 1990. He enjoyed his hobbies of fishing, and woodworking until the spring of this year when he returned to Holliston to live with his son.
