H.S.A. member Dan Holmes participated in the 2010 N.R.A. National Matches in July. In addition to being selected for the U.S.A. Dewar Team he also took 1st place in the Prone Championships in his class (out of 47 shooters). Congratulations Dan! As a point of information:

“In the United States serious conventional prone shooters measure excellence by earning membership on one, or more, of the major prone matches shot in the English speaking world . . . regardless of gender, for all smallbore prone competitors, there is no more prestigious postal match to fire than The National Smallbore Rifle Association (NSRA) of Great Britain's Dewar Trophy International Match.”
