Biggest bass in inches wins a \$25 gift certificate to Lunkers in Ashland. Tournament headquarters will be at the Pleasure Point launch ramp. ## H.S.A. Official Match Bulletin

### Holliston Sportsmen's Association 3 Gun 900 Match June 22, 2004 - 7:00PM

Competition Open to: All H.S.A. Senior and Life Members.

Entry Fee: \$10

Awards: Over all winner (highest combined score of three matches) wins 1/3 of entry fees. Highest single 300 match score wins 1/3 of entry fees.

NRA Pistol Rules apply;

1. Course of fire:  
All stages will use the NRA B-2 Slow Fire and B-3 Timed and Rapid fire Pistol Targets at 50 feet on the indoor range. All stages will consist of 10 shots. All stages will be off-hand using a one hand hold. No fouling or sighting shots allowed.

#### 300 Match 1 - .22 caliber Pistol or Revolver

Stage 1 Slow Fire: 10 shots, in 10 minutes on the B-2 target;

Stage 2 Timed Fire: 5 shots in 20 seconds (2 times) on the B-3 target;

Stage 3 Rapid fire: 5 shots in 10 seconds (2 times) on the B-3 target;

#### 300 Match 2 - Centerfire Revolver

Stage 1 Slow Fire: 10 shots, in 10 minutes on the B-2 target;

Stage 2 Timed Fire: 5 shots in 20 seconds (2 times) on the B-3 target;

Stage 3 Rapid fire: 5 shots in 10 seconds (2 times) on the B-3 target;

#### 300 Match 3 - Centerfire Pistol

Stage 1 Slow Fire: 10 shots, in 10 minutes on the B-2 target;

Stage 2 Timed Fire: 5 shots in 20 seconds (2 times) on the B-3 target;

Stage 3 Rapid fire: 5 shots in 10 seconds (2 times) on the B-3 target;

2. Firearms:

Match 1 - Any pistol or revolver chambered for .22 caliber rimfire cartridge only;

Match 2 - Any revolver chambered for a centerfire cartridge;

Match 3 - Any pistol chambered for a centerfire cartridge;

No restrictions on sights, weights, grip configuration, or trigger pull;

The same firearm must be used for all stages of any one match except in the case of a disabled firearm or malfunction, when competitors may change firearms with range officer permission.

3. Clothing - No clothing with padding or straps or other provisions for tightening, or constructed with any material intended to make the shoulders or other parts more rigid. Shoes shall be a matched pair and not designed or altered in any way so as to provide artificial support. Gloves are not permitted. Eye and ear protection are required.
